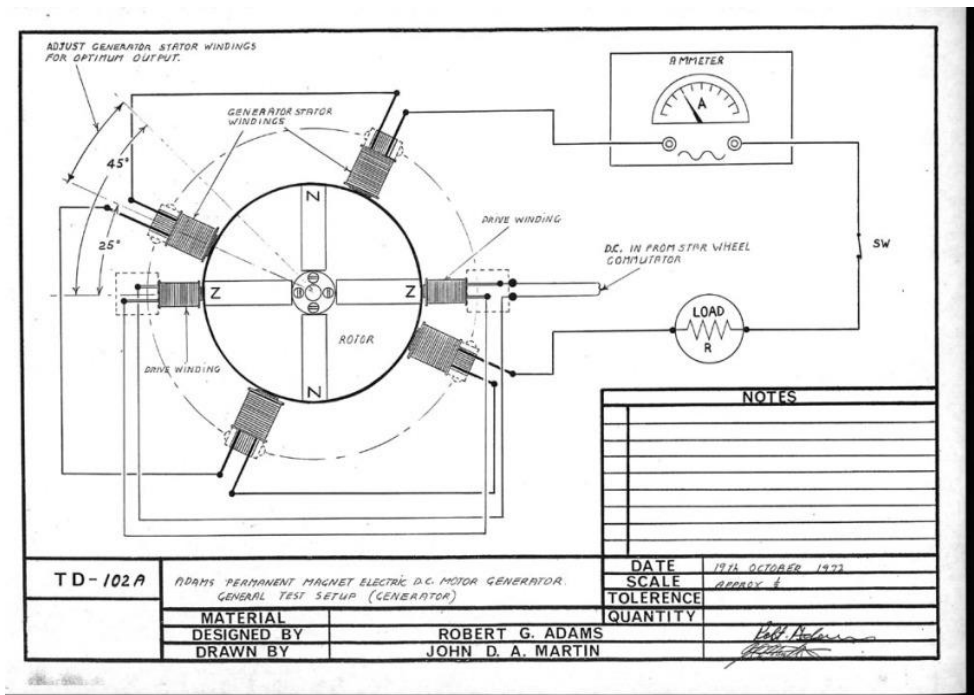

Dear Alexander,

Greetings once again. I must thank you for your prompt reply dated 24 July 1994 and also apologise for the long delay in responding to that. There has been much of late for me to attend to.

You have answered my questions to my satisfaction and I will be pleased to continue correspondence with you on certain matters pertaining to your ideas and aspirations.

For the immediate present, however, I have to advise you that I see no current prospect of either of us combining our resources, due, in the main, to lack of finance and, by that, I mean the KIND of finance that would see us both adequately and comfortably accommodated in order to work together appropriately. The idea of a joint laboratory venture on this project between our two countries would require such geographical attachments and extensive consequent capital outlay for a period of up to two years in the initial stages and security of such absolute capacity that I can not envisage the investment of such magnitude from your Country's point of view. In such a case, it would therefore occur to me that this alternative would be neither probable or viable.

Conversely, however, your own idea of perhaps coming to New Zealand to work for my group as an engineer/researcher has merit and may hold some possibility in the future. Within a year from now I may possibly be in a position to offer you some kind of a proposition, as the development of the Adams Motor is progressing well at present here in New Zealand and it's future appears bright. At this stage, however, I can promise nothing but please do keep corresponding and contact me if anything of a concrete nature comes along your way.

Should, however, you become cognizant of any Russian investors who may propound interest in my device, it would be prudent for them to make contact with me direct through Robert Adams Developments Ltd at the above address, in the immediate interim, to register and secure their interests.

I have no way of contacting Mr. Loktev in Russian text - Russian interpreters over here are uncommon. Mr. Loktev must find a way of contacting me in the English language for any discussions he may wish to conduct with me.

Mr. Gray of N.Z. has had no contact with me for well over a year now.

Dear Alexander,

I hope we have got your email address correctly. I will fax a copy of this email to you just in case we have not. Please confirm you have received this either as an email or a fax, or both please.

I apologise for the typists error, i.e., "Ian Butler". Of course I mean "Tom" Butler. My "T's" often are mis-scribed as "I"'s.

In answer to your questions in your fax of the 21st August 2002 -

- 1) Yes, I recommend first machines should be able to accommodate the requirements of homes with families, workshops, offices, small outback schools, doctors surgeries, hospitals, etc., i.e., (10 kw).
- 2) Patents in the Western World countries are not in any way protection any longer. Blatant manipulation of patents in Australia, New Zealand and USA are rampant as with most of the Asian countries as well. I suggest you study my own experiences of this flouting of Patent Law on my website [www.aethuogen.com](http://www.aethuogen.com)
- 3) Reference Demo - Cannot promise this as my proving demo machine has recently been burnt out again for the fourth time due to "runaway", caused by insufficient water flow. New machines are under construction at present to avoid this problem. However, you will be able to see from the general construction of the machines, their abilities to perform as stated. I have nobody here at present who can be trusted and is capable to carry out this major re-build. Also I am too involved in writing papers, interviewing and consulting with visitors from overseas.
- 4) Yes, I would agree to a joint venture with appropriate conditions applying, i.e., shareholding and percentage licensing right advance payment, time parameters envisaged, source of funding and manufacturing, development, location and resources, legal, fiscal and all other costs envisaged in the project. All these things must be looked into first before any contract can be negotiated. I, of course, will require those interest in Russia to pay to me a Negotiation Settlement Fee which is a fee to enable me to employ my own legal representatives. This is how I am currently operating negotiations with other overseas interests at present and those interested consider this normal business procedure.

Having said the above I must now be very honest and straightforward with you Alexander> I am in a predicament like a spider caught in his own web. I have become under intense pressure of late from some very very big overseas conglomerates who have literally thousands of millions of dollars to fling around and who have attempted to constrain me to them alone. I simply do not know what to do - they want exclusivity totally, i.e. worldwide rights! There are five of them altogether as at this stage neither one of them known to the other. God knows I do not want any more. Each and every one of them have

to try and tie me down. I could, of course, sell it outright and all my worries would be over, hopefully. I am well between a rock and a hard place. My years are also against me. Even with the assistance and counsel I am receiving from my attorneys I am confused as to what to do. I have always sworn that there is plenty for everybody and that this technology can be shared but the monster of greed is slowly trying to suffocate me. What do I do? I would appreciate any advice you can give me.
